

#### Survey Methodology

- Surveys were distributed to Carson City residents and stakeholders through a variety of media:
  - ▶ In Person
    - ► Senior Center Annual Pass Sign Up Event (Late June)
    - ▶ Major bus stops including Downtown Transfer Plaza, Walmart North, and Public Library
  - ▶ Public bulletin boards, such as:
    - ▶ Grocery Stores
    - ▶ Churches
    - ▶ Public Facilities (Community Center, Library, City Hall, etc.)
  - Online/In Print
    - ▶ Carson Now
    - ▶ Public Works Facebook Page
    - ▶ Carson City Nextdoor Page
- ▶ 88 responses between June 28 and August 4, 2021.

### Age of Participants (Q11; N=82)




- Strong response from senior community due in part to annual transit event at Senior Center.

- Seniors represent approx. 40% of JAC fixed-route ridership in 2018.


#### Primary Transit Purpose(s)


- Riders use JAC for a wide variety of purposes.

Level of Satisfaction with Existing Routes





## Service Improvements Ranked by Importance








- Respondents are largely in support of or unaffected by this change.

(Q6; N=75)






Will the consolidation of Routes 2A and 2B into a single Route 2 and the addition of service along Saliman Road make your trips easier or more difficult?

  - ➤ 2A/2B currently provide redundant service, which will end as proposed.
  - Reduction in service creates opportunity for increased bus coverage.
